

## Facilities Technician – Electrical

### What's the role?

Working as part of a small team the successful candidate will be responsible for planned and reactive maintenance of the airport's electrical systems, including: single & three phase power, lighting, UPS, power generators, pumps, motors. As part of the technical services team the successful applicant will also be responsible for maintaining the terminal systems and supporting external infrastructure on the airport; it is essential that the successful candidate is willing to support these additional areas of the business.

### What will I be responsible for?

- Maintaining the airport's electrical systems in accordance with current legislation
- Maintaining a detailed register of the airport's electrical assets along with associated drawings and schematics
- Ensuring that all fixed wiring is periodically inspected and tested in accordance with current legislation
- Installing new electrical services/systems in accordance with current legislation
- Ensuring that all faults are prioritised and resolved in a timely fashion so that down time is kept to an absolute minimum
- Maintain airport specific systems/equipment in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations
- Maintain building services and building fabric in accordance with ACoPs, national guidelines and or LSA procedures
- Promote safe working practices at all times, this includes the development of task specific risk assessment
- Liaise/escort third party contractors at times to support the facilities team
- Identify and report the need for major repairs
- Ensure that all maintenance facilities and equipment are used in accordance with current health and safety regulations, and that good housekeeping standards are maintained at all times
- To undertake any other reasonable task as requested by the Technical Services Manager, subject to being trained and competent to do so.



## Qualifications and Experience:

- Must have been a registered Apprentice or undergone some equivalent method of training in practical electrical installation work.
- Must have obtained a Level 3 NVQ in Electro-Technical Services (Electrical Installation – Buildings & Structures) or the Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Installing Electro-technical systems and equipment (buildings, structures and the environment) or approved equivalent
- Must have obtained the Level 3 technical certificate relevant to the NVQ either as part of the NVQ Diploma or as a separate qualification (such as the City & Guilds 2360 Electrical Installation Theory and Practice Part 2 or Level 3 Certificate in Electro-Technical Technology - or approved equivalent).
- Must have five years' experience working as an approved electrician
- Must have a sound working knowledge of the National Working Rules for the Electrical Contracting Industry, the current IET Wiring Regulations for the Requirements of Electrical Installations BS7671, and the Construction Industry Safety Regulations.
- Must be competent raising and working under permits to work/sanctions to test
- Must be competent at working from complex system drawings and schematics
- Experience installing and maintaining three phase motors and associated control systems including Siemens M200D
- Experienced in fault finding and trouble shooting
