- Maintain their required level of technical competencies as defined by Southend Fire Service Standards and as agreed by the regulator in order to uphold the airport licence
- Maintaining all PPE and ensuring all uniform issue is kept clean and in a good state of repair
- Routine housekeeping of Station facilities & assisting with station maintenance and improvements
- Promote and adopt safe working practices to ensure that self, colleagues and customers are not put at risk, and that health, safety, and environment are given the highest priority at all times
- To be responsible for the effective deployment and appropriate use of relevant equipment and facilities ensuring optimum deployment
- Maintain equipment for operational readiness to specified standards in order to meet internal and external audit requirements.
- Be responsible for personal and team compliance with Company Health and Safety Policies, ensuring safe working practices to minimise risk to self, work colleagues, customers and staff is minimised
