What's the role?

Working within a small team, the successful candidate will be required to support various maintenance tasks associated with airport operations. Your primary responsibilities will be completing planned and reactive maintenance on the Aeronautical Ground Lighting system, specific AGL training will be provided by the company where necessary.

- Reporting equipment status.
- Fault investigation and rectification.
- Carryout out any reasonable task requested by your line manager to support the airport operation.
- Carryout key operational tasks out of hours.
